Student Profile

In the 12-month period ending Aug. 31, 2013, at TCAT Elizabethton the program completion rate was 90 percent; the job placement rate was 90 percent; and the licensure passage rate was 92 percent on the Tennessee Board of Nursing exam.

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TCAT ELIZABETHTON CONSOLIDATED CAMPUS

We are growing to provide the job skills needed by employers and students in Northeast Tennessee. Pictured is the 12-acre tract of the Main Campus of the Tennessee College of Applied Technology Elizabethton campus, located at 426 Highway 91 North, across from the Elizabethton Municipal Airport in the Watauga Industrial Park. We just completed a \$16 million campus consolidation construction project to add three new buildings and renovate a fourth building. The footprint of the main campus has 95,000 square feet of classroom and shop space for 10 full-time programs that meet 30 hours per week, which may be completed in 12 to 20 months.

Full-time (30 hours per week) training programs that take 12 to 20 months to complete

- **Administrative Office Technology**
- **Automotive Technology**
- **Computer Information Technology**
- **Diesel Powered Equipment**
- **Electricity/Electronics**
- **HVAC/Refrigeration**
- **Millwright Skills**
- **Pipefitting and Plumbing**
- **Practical Nursing**
- **Welding**

Requirements: A high school diploma or equivalent is required to enroll in Administrative Office Technology, Electricity/Electronics, Millwright Skills, Pipefitting and Plumbing and Practical Nursing.

Awards: Graduates receive a Diploma upon completion of each training program. Certificates of Completion are awarded at various exit points, except Practical Nursing.

Cost: The registration fee for full-time students (attending 30 hours per week) who are enrolled in day classes is approximately \$1,000 per trimester.

Financial Assistance: For students who qualify, approximately \$1,881 will be available from the Federal Pell Grant, per trimester, and \$667, per trimester, from the Tennessee Lottery.
