Clery Act Campus Safety and Security Reporting

To comply with the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act, the Tennessee College of Applied Technology Elizabethton prepares this report. Campus crime, arrest and referral statistics include those reported to law enforcement agencies, designated campus officials, including but not limited to president, vice president, student services coordinator and office manager, as well as law enforcement agencies, to gather the information herein.

In accordance with the fire statistics, safety, and prevention requirements of the Higher Education Opportunity Act, the Tennessee College of Applied Technology Elizabethton prepares and posts on the college website a Campus Safety and Security Report on or before October 1 of each calendar year. The report covers the previous 12 month calendar year. The Tennessee College of Applied Technology Elizabethton does not provide or supervise any student housing. Therefore, the report only has on campus statistics.

Annual Security Report

The Tennessee College of Applied Technology Elizabethton is required by federal law to also publish an Annual Security Report by October 1 each year. Fire Safety Report

College facilities include the following: smoke and fire monitors and fire alarms in each building on campus; pull down alarms in each building; an ADT notification system in event of a fire that sends a fire alarm to the 911 emergency command center in Elizabethton; closed circuit video cameras, with audio, that provide both interior and exterior building coverage; and a public address system with audio and flashing strobe lights for hearing impaired are located in each building and classroom, all in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
