Position Available Practical Nursing Adjunct Clinical Instructor

The Tennessee College of Applied Technology, Elizabethton/Kingsport is accepting applications for the position of part-time Practical Nursing Adjunct Clinical Instructor. This position will work less than 30 hours per week. A high standard of personal and professional ethics with a sincere interest in teaching and in nursing is desired.

Position Summary: To provide supervision and instruction for student learning in clinical facilities.

Required qualifications:

- Graduate of an accredited nursing school with an active license in Tennessee as a Registered Nurse.
- A minimum of an associate degree in nursing is required.
- Minimum of three years of experience as a registered nurse within the last five years, or two years clinical practice as registered nurse with 24 semester hours toward a higher degree.

General Duties:

- Supervise student clinical experience as scheduled.
- Provide individual evaluation of student progress with counseling and appropriate recommendations when required.
- Maintain confidential, accurate, and complete student records.
- Maintain ongoing competencies as required for RN licensure.

Salary: Commensurate with experience and according to salary guidelines established by the Tennessee Board of Regents.
