The Criminal Justice curriculum is structured to deliver extensive training to correctional and law enforcement personnel. The coursework provides a thorough understanding of inmate processing, the maintenance of order within a correctional facility, and the proper application of disciplinary actions. In addition to these core competencies, officers will learn to conduct thorough cell searches for contraband, perform facility inspections for cleanliness.

This one-trimester program incorporates crucial instruction on emergency procedures, mental health and first aid, defensive tactics, use-of-force policies, ethics, legal issues, investigation techniques, and professional development.

This Correctional Officer Program provides hands-on, practical, and theoretical instruction to prepare students for certifications and local agency employment.
