



Classes start – Jan, May, & Sept Online Dietary Manager Training Program

Course Description

An 8-month part-time <u>online program</u> designed to meet the educational needs of individuals desiring to work as Dietary Managers. Dietary Managers work together with Registered Dietitians to provide quality nutritional care for patients/residents. They are involved in food procurement services, sanitation, food and safety, as well as administrative/personnel management. The program will consist of 714 web-based hours and 150 hours of field experience training. The program is approved by the Association of Nutrition & Foodservice Professionals (ANFP) and is designed to prepare graduates to take the National Credentialing Exam to become a Certified Dietary Manager (CDM).
